How Nebraska's Natural Resources Districts function:

- All 23 NRDs are organized as governmental subdivisions of the State of Nebraska.
- Local control is provided by a Board of Directors, elected by voters within each District.
- Across the state, NRDs offer a major source of assistance and regulations where necessary—to landowners in conservation and natural resources management.
- Locally elected NRD Board of Directors are given a broad range of authority to manage within the context of state laws.
- This authority includes the power to tax, regulate & enforce rules/regulations, reform, monitor, educate, research, facilitate, assist and provide financial incentives.
